

SEEK-A-BOO! MEMORY MATCH GAME



This fun, active game helps young children learn the names of colors, shapes, animals, foods, and more while seeking and finding each match.

MATCH GAME

Place the circle photos on the floor. Show your toddler one of your cards and see if she can find the matching photo. Point out features she might recognize, "Can you match my **yellow** banana?"

MEMORY MATCH

Start with a few matches and have your toddler turn over two cards to try and find a match. Give hints to remind her and ask "Do you remember where the dog is?"

WORD GAME

Playing Seek-a-Boo! can be a fun way to introduce your toddler to new words. Use rich adjectives words to describe the nouns. "Can you find the furry kitten?"

MY TURN, YOUR TURN

Play Seek-a-Boo! with your toddler to develop social skills such as turn-taking. Use words like, "You go first, I go next". "Now it's your turn." "Great waiting."
